**Background:** Technobox, Inc has been in business since 1989, but actively involved on a full time basis for the design of printed circuit board assemblies since approximately 1994. It is a well-known and well established company in the embedded systems marketplace, and specifically focuses on Mezzanine Cards. The company has constructed a state-of-the-art SMT facility consisting of advanced equipment and processes not normally found on an SMT line.

**Job Description:** This is a manufacturing position involving the assembly of Electronic Printed Circuit Boards. It is a multi-faceted job which also includes inventory control, electronics assembly testing, mechanical assembly, soldering, and packaging/shipping. There are other people in the facility with similar responsibilities, and it is expected there will develop a cooperative effort between personnel as needed to accomplish company goals. The Electronics Manufacturing Associate will be directed by a production supervisor. A summary of activities:

- 1. Mechanical assembly and hand soldering of printed circuit board assemblies, such as screwing down components and soldering thru-hole devices.
- 2. As needed, assisting with pulling inventory and loading on equipment, such as on the pick and place machine.
- 3. As needed, assisting Operating equipment, including stencil printer, pick and place machine, vapor phase oven, washing machine, and selective soldering equipment.
- 4. Inspecting printed circuit assembles for manufacturing flaws, using AOI equipment.
- 5. Testing printed circuit assemblies by plugging into a Personal Computer and running tests.
- 6. Incoming receiving and inspection of electronic components. Opening boxes, etc.
- 7. Maintenance of component inventory, including counting, packaging and the like.
- 8. Pulling finished goods inventory and packaging for shipment to customers.
- 9. Other tasks determined consistent with the "Electronics Manufacturing Associate" responsibilities.

**Hours:** full time 8 hrs per day, non-exempt. Starting time from 7:00 to 8:00 AM consistent with other employees. Ending time approximately 4:00 PM. Lunch not included.
